Admission Procedure

For admissions in Aziz Fatimah Nursing College (AFNC) all eligible candidates can apply regardless of gender, race or religion. Admissions will be purely on merit basis.

Selection Process consists of written entrance test and interview.

Admission to 01 Year Diploma in Pupil Midwifery is free. Financial support in the form of scholarship is also available. Code of Conduct

- **1.** Students are required to wear full uniform during college and hospital. Jewellery, ear rings, painted fingernails, threads and bracelets on hands etc. are not allowed. Students must be neat and tidy in their dress, avoiding exaggerated fashions.
- **2.** Students are required to carry their identity cards during college hours, clinical and whenever they are going out for field visits.
- **3.** Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards in behavior both inside and outside the college, hospital, hostel and community premises.
- **4.** Students should maintain silence in the classes, library, reading room and in the corridors.
- **5.** Students should make every effort to take care of the college and hospital property and help in maintaining the same.

Each student is responsible for the proper handling and safe custody of any apparatus or equipment that he/she may be using in different labs. Misuse or negligence will result in replacement of the particular by the candidate.

- **6.** Each student must have at least 85% attendance at the end of the each year of education. Students will not be allowed to appear in university annual exam with attendance less than 85%. Repeated absence from classes and hospital duties will make a student liable to expulsion from the College.
- **7.** No student will be allowed to take the examination unless he/she clear all the dues.
- Students are not allowed to leave lecture hall or hospital without permission. If the students have any problem, they should inform the class representative the and class representative will intimate it to the Program coordinators. If the problem is not solved at the coordinator's Program level, then the Program coordinator will present it to the Principal. No students should by-pass the above mentioned channels. Exceptions are allowed only if the problem is utmost urgent/serious.
- **9.** A student nurse is not allowed to receive gift or gratuity of any sort at any time from the patients of the hospital or their relatives.

Evaluation and Examination

Internal Assessment:

The continuous internal assessment shall contribute 10% to the total allocated marks for each subject in a professional examination. Awards of internal assessment will be equally distributed to the final Theory and Oral/Practical scores of a candidate and not to an individual component like MCQs, SEQs paper or Oral/Practical/ Clinical Examination.

Eligibility of students to appear in University Exams:

- The professional examination shall be open to any student who is certified by the Principal Nursing College for bearing:
 - Good character
 - Having attended not less than 85% of the full course of lectures delivered and practical/tutorial conducted in each subject.
 - Having cleared all the dues
- A candidate who fails in one or more subjects in a Professional Examination of University of Health Science Lahore shall, if he/she so desires, provisionally be allowed to join the next higher class till the commencement of supplementary examination. The candidate, however, will have to pass the failed subjects in the supplementary examination failing which he/she will be detained in that previous class. Under no circumstances, a candidate will be promoted to next higher class till he/she has passed the Professional Examination of preceding class.
